- Increase the number of students achieving PM reading levels above North Queensland Region (NQR) reading regression levels
 - Prep – 9
 - Year 1 – 24
 - Year 2 – 30

Our initiatives include


- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of highly effective teaching pedagogy and the use of the gradual release of responsibility model
- Improve teaching capability within the school wide planning process, developing understanding of the alignment process to gain understanding of the Australian Curriculum, standards of achievement and Curriculum into the Classroom (C2C)
- Build teaching capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a pedagogical coach to deepen teachers' understanding of the gradual release of responsibility model. The coach will maintain contact throughout the year and will make face-to-face visits at least once a term to give feedback and profile teachers \$4000
- Purchase an IT specialist to maintain computer software and provide professional development to teachers \$2781
- Purchase teacher time to allow for collaborative planning to improve teacher capability and understanding of the alignment process from the Australian Curriculum, standards of achievement and C2C. \$3500
- Purchase an interactive LED screen to allow all students to gain access to technology that will differentiate and improve learning \$6500
