Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing a master teacher to deepen teachers' understanding of the gradual release of responsibility model. The coach will maintain contact throughout the year and will make face-to-face visits once per term to give feedback and work alongside teachers: **\$3,750**

Purchasing TRS to allow for collaborative inquiries into the reading and writing demands of C2C assessment tasks and the teaching of reading and writing: **\$6,000**

Improving teacher capability within the school wide planning process, developing understanding of the alignment process to gain understanding of the Australian Curriculum, standards of achievement and C2C: **\$3,653**
