This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students spelling at or above their chronological age from 80% (2016) to 100% (2017).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' or higher in English from 90% (2016) to 100% (2017).
- 100% improvement in termly student reading achievements against regional regression targets.

Our initiatives include

- Increase teacher's repertoire of effective strategies in the areas of spelling, reading and writing.
- Build teacher capability in Quality Teaching and Learning and embed it as the shared language of teacher and learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing a pedagogical coach to improve knowledge and practice of the high yield strategies involved with the gradual release model and creating assessment literate learners. The coach will maintain contact throughout the year and be required to make face-to-face visits once per term. \$1,920
- Engage a Support Teacher to allow for a comprehensive implementation of Pentland State School's Quality Teaching and Learning framework. Specifically employed to ensure that all students are being taught with a focus on literacy. \$5,230
