This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a B or higher in English and from 61% (2019) to 90% (2020)
- Increase the amount of students achieving Pentland PM reading levels targets:
 - Prep – 9
 - Year 1 – 24
 - Year 2 – 30

Our initiatives include

- Implement Age Appropriate pedagogies in K-2 years
- Provide coaching and mentoring to deepen teachers' understandings of highly effective teaching pedagogy
- Provide targeted professional development in reading and spelling to increase teacher and teacher aide capability in effective teaching practices

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a pedagogical coach to deepen teachers' understanding of the gradual release of responsibility model. The coach will make face-to-face visits at least once a term to give feedback and profile teachers and teach aides. (\$2000)
- Employ a teacher to maintain the current two classrooms to allow effective teaching and learning in the kindergarten program and early years. (\$14 380)
